DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

The Housing Authority of the County of Jackson is Authorized to solicit information for the principal purpose of determining eligibility for housing programs. Information provided may be used outside the Housing Authority for the following purpose:

- 1. Release to interested parties who submit requests under the Freedom of Information Act.
- 2. To provide the basis for housing success stories in Housing Authority news releases and reports.
- 3. Referral to the appropriate law enforcement agency.
- 4. Referral to employers, businesses, landlords, and creditors.
- 5. Referral to any other government bodies or governmental agencies including the Department of Health and Human Resources.
- 6. Referral to a credit reporting agency.
- 7. HUD uses the information for budget development, program evaluation and planning, and reports to the President and Congress. HUD also uses the information to monitor compliance with Federal requirements on eligibility and rent and to verify the accuracy and completeness of the income information.

The information must be provided to HUD so that it can carry out its monitoring and data collection responsibilities. Failure to do so may result in denial, eviction, or the withdrawal of housing assistance (depending on the housing program).

HUD is permitted to ask for the information by the U.S. Housing Act of 1937 as amended, 42 U.S.C., 1437 et. seg., the Housing and Community Development Act of 1981, Public Law 97-35, 85 Stat., 348, 408.

Every effort will be made to protect the privacy of applications and participants.
